 Sarah Barfoot of Walsfield in the County of Leicestershire widow first
 I commended my soul into the hands of Almighty God who gave it in
 robes of a blissful resurrection thro' the merits of my Saviour Jesus
 Christ and my body I commit to the Earth to be decently buried at the
 discretion of my Executors whom I name as to my worldly goods I dispose
 of them in manner following that I give and bequeath to my nephew
 James Dibley the silver watch of my late husband Peter Barfoot
 and a gold ring given bequeath to my nephew Robert William Dibley
 a pair of silver shoe buckles & a gold ring given bequeath to my
 nephew Henry Dimmock a gold ring given bequeath to my nephew
 my wearing apparel and linen to be equally divided between Henry
 Dimmock Robert William Dibley and James Dibley as to
 all the remainder of my property of whatsover nature or kind the same
 may be that I shall stand possessed of at the time of my decease I give
 and bequeath the same to be equally divided between the aforementioned
 Henry Dimmock the aforementioned Robert and James Dibley & William
 Dibley of the Parish of Walsfield & Edmund Steward of the Parishes
 of Walsfield in the County of Leicestershire and assigns lastly I
 constitute and appoint the aforementioned Edmund Steward Robert William Dibley
 James Dibley of the County of Leicestershire and William Dibley
 Executors of this my last Will and Testament in writing which I have
 caused to be signed and sealed the twenty sixth day of January in the
 year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and seven - The last
 of Sarah Barfoot - I have sealed published and declared by the
 said Sarah Barfoot as and for her last Will and Testament in the presence of
 us who in her presence and in the presence of each other and at her
 request have subscribed our names as witnesses thereto - John Watts - Roger

On the 29th day of ^{the year} 1799 at half past four o'clock in the afternoon before me
 Johannes van der Pijper Notary public at Amsterdam admitted by the Honble Court of
 Holland and in the presence of the aforementioned notary appeared of the said
 Johanna Elizabeth Beels residing in this City upon the ~~place~~ ^{street} ~~street~~ ^{street} known
 to me notary being fully able to say these words as fully appeared unto me in
 consideration of the certainty of death and the uncertain time & hour thereof
 resolved to make her Testament as follows first the said Johanna Elizabeth Beels
 all Testaments Codicils & other acts bearing the name of a last will made by
 her before the date hereof either separately or jointly with other persons and
 hereby do hereby publicly and in the said City of Amsterdam declare to be null and
 void the said Johanna Elizabeth Beels wife of the Honble Edward de Burellt Junr in
 Commission of this City & all her said Johanna Elizabeth Beels bequeathing appoint
 & give unto William Woollen her son & his heirs all the goods & chattels which
 shall be included in the aforesaid denominations & his heirs part & share thereof
 all the said Johanna Elizabeth Beels parts debts & gold and silver plate & jewels
 which she hath all having belonging to her the said Johanna Elizabeth Beels
 excepted and to all the rest of her said Johanna Elizabeth Beels shall leave
 behind either moveable or immovable goods debts credits rights & claims
 nothing excepted the said Johanna Elizabeth Beels declared to substitute for her
 sole universal heirs her sister & brothers the before named Johanna Maria Beels
 married to the Honble Edward de Burellt Junr the Honble Leonard Beels & Jacob
 Nicolaus Beels & their heirs and assigns at the precedence of one or more of them
 in case the said Johanna Elizabeth Beels should die intestate by default of her
 executors of whom she the said Johanna Elizabeth Beels constituting appointing
 & giving the said Johanna Elizabeth Beels & her heirs & assigns of the funeral
 & burial of her minor heirs & legates in case there should be any & assigns
